Notes from Fr. Jimmy

The Feast of Assumption:

The Solemnity of the Assumption on Tuesday, reminds us of the many graces God has bestowed on the Blessed Virgin, especially that she was raised up to heaven to be united with her Son. In 1950, Pope Pius XII officially recognized the assumption of Mary into heaven as part of divine revelation. The well-known prayer, Litany of the Blessed Virgin, addresses Mary as the "cause of our joy." This title of Mary is most appropriate for the feast of her Assumption into heaven. This is a Holy Day of Obligation this year, so please see the Mass time for our Parishes. Mary's entire being found joy in the Lord. She spread that joy to others, even the pre-born baby John, who leapt for joy at the sound of Mary's voice as she carried Jesus into their home in her womb (Lk 1:44). Mary was also present in the upper room at Pentecost (Acts 1:14ff) and surely exulted with joy as her Spouse, the Holy Spirit, filled the apostles, who then brought three thousand people into the Church.

Finally, Mary was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory (<u>Catechism</u>, <u>966</u>). "She already shares in the glory of her Son's Resurrection, anticipating the resurrection of all members of His Body" (<u>Catechism</u>, <u>974</u>). She has been "exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things, so that she might be the more fully conformed to her Son" (<u>Catechism</u>, <u>966</u>). Her assumption is a sign of sure hope (LG 68, Vatican II) that Jesus will raise us up to live with Him forever.

The Lord in His word commands us to rejoice with Mary as she is honored as the mother of the Church. Since Mary is honored, all the members share her joy. Wish you every blessing of this amazing feast of Mary, our Mother!
