Notes from Fr. Jimmy

THE HOLY EUCHARIST, THE BASIC SACRAMENT

Blessed Carlo Acutis, a young boy, who passed away in 2006, was beatified October 10, 2020 in Assisi, Italy, is proving to the world that you don't need to be rich, famous, crazy smart or the coolest kid in school to make an impact. He once said, "To be always close to Jesus, that's my life plan." And that is what this teenager exemplified in the short time he spent on this earth. We look to his example of holiness because of his great love for the Eucharist in both the ordinary and the extraordinary moments of life, particularly during his battle with leukemia, which took his life at age 15.

Carlo's words say it all: "Jesus is Love, and He has made himself food and drink for us in the Eucharist. The more we nourish ourselves on the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Christ, the more we will be able to love... The Eucharist configures us in a special way to God, who is Love." This teenager from Italy is a special intercessor for the National Eucharistic Revival.

The importance of the Eucharist in Christian Spirituality is an undisputable fact. The Eucharist offers us an action plan for Life. When Jesus said 'Do this in memory of me' he was inviting all people to begin a new life style; a life of sharing their blessings and bearing others burdens. The Eucharist being so precious and beyond human imagination in its significance in our lives, it is vitally important to approach this sacrament with right respect and disposition.

I will be making some suggestions for how to make our participation in the Eucharist meaningful and experiential in next week's bulletin.
