Notes from Fr. Jimmy

Another School Year!

As Christians we are being formed in our faith, traditions and holiness of Life. From the very beginning of life until our last breath we are being formed and prepared for the life eternal. We receive our faith from our parents and we transfer it to the next generation. We can see an ongoing process of growing in our faith.

Faith formation is a lifelong activity of expanding our conscious awareness through communal experiences that stretch us as humans into new ways of being. We don't always know when that will happen. The important thing is to provide inviting and inclusive environments so that our children, youth and adults can explore their life stories within the greater context of a connected community. Everything we do as a congregation is faith formation, not just what happens in religious education classes. Everything we do together, consciously or unconsciously, is a part of the curriculum of the congregation. We are all engaged in an interplay of teaching and learning as a community. Through these interchanges we develop our foundation; our spiritual rock upon which our individual and communal faith grows.

We know that to transmit our faith we must live it. The Catholic faith is not just an aspect of our lives, but it is our whole life. Today's secular culture, which teaches from youth that devotion to God is a private matter, makes this difficult to see. Our society makes us ashamed not only to speak about God in the workplace or to our neighbors, we are even hesitant to show a vibrant faith to our own children. In fact, we often feel uncomfortable with our own religious desires. As a result, we rely too much on Sunday Mass and Catholic schools or CCD programs to teach our children. In order to evangelize our children, we must first develop our personal religious life. We can't give what we don't have. To do this, we must participate in the Sacraments as much as possible.

Our tri-parish faith formation classes will begin in two weeks. I want to encourage all parents to seriously consider sending your children to this program of our Church. The Faith Formation Program is the most important part of the Church and as a worshipping community it is our responsibility to help the next generation to grow in FAITH. I humbly ask you, all parents, to take this as part of your responsibility to help your children to attend and benefit this Program. My sincere thanks to the DRE's, who have been working behind the scenes for many weeks already preparing for this year; to our teachers and aides; to parents who support the classroom work and faith experiences by reinforcing those lessons at home and at the Sunday Eucharist; and to all who give of their time and prayer to make this important work of the Church a reality.
