But now Jesus has set off for Jerusalem that leads to the cross. I hope and pray that your summer is grace-filled. Next week, I will be going up north for some rest and relaxation. I am so blessed to have this opportunity. I know many of you do not have this luxury. This will be a time for me to recharge as oftentimes vacations can include many different activities which can be exhausting. I love to simply slow down and reflect on the beauty of God's creation. Nothing more beautiful than hearing the symphony of the outdoors while listening to the still small voice of Our Loving God. Know of my prayers for you. I will also have Mass for each of our parishes. I will be staying in the Lake Itasca area. I will have a 9am Sunday Mass at St Catherine's.

Every three years, all parishes are asked to have a mission presentation coordinated through our Mission Office/Society of the Propagation of the Faith in St Cloud. This is a wonderful opportunity to be exposed and supportive to a specific mission activity within our global church. The weekend of July 9-10, our three parishes will be blessed to Dr. David Paige speak at our Masses. He has been to India about fifteen times. He is part of 'Homes for Hope/Franciscan Clarist Congregation'. They minister in the area of Lamabari, India which is a place of extreme poverty. Many of the young women and girls are from the neighboring tribes who unfortunately face horrible discrimination similar to the Untouchable or Dalits. Without a home and education, they will be lured into the sex slave and sex trafficking industry.
