Notes from Father David

The beginning of our Lord's public ministry, after His Baptism in the River Jordan, is still on our minds. Just two weeks ago we celebrated the Baptism of the Lord. We hear today about the early stages of the Lord's ministry, when He was gradually being recognized as a Rabbi, a Teacher of the people, with a very clear message: "Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand." And where exactly is the Kingdom or Reign of God? Within us and among us! Christ is in our midst, as the Light of the Nations and the Glory of God's people, the Church. Jesus has come to establish the new Israel, God's people, who need to be ready and willing to take up the Gospel.

Have you heard about the extreme abortion bill? Abortion advocates have won a narrow majority in the Minnesota legislature. Now some state lawmakers want to pass bills that would: create a new law (or constitutional amendment) allowing the abortion of any unborn baby, for any reason and done any time until birth; establish that Minnesota law gives parents no right at all to know if their minor daughter is undergoing an abortion, even though parental consent is required for all other medical procedures; establish in law a requirement that even those with deeply held pro-life convictions must pay for the killing of the unborn with their tax dollars.

To think that only seven countries in the world have an abortion law so extreme, among them China and North Korea! Reach out to your legislators before the end of January 2023. You can find your representatives and their contact info at this link: https://www.leg.mn.gov/leg/legdir Protect Reproductive Options (PRO) Act [H.F. 1] passes Minnesota House Committee. According to MCCL Co-Executive Director Cathy Blaeser. "This bill means a 'right' to abort any baby for any reason at any time until birth. Women and children deserve so much better."
