## St. Cloud seminarians will experience revisions to seminary formation this fall

The newly-added Propaedeutic stage occurs before men begin collegiate level study. It "seeks to provide seminarians with the basic groundwork they need to engage in priestly formation," according to the Program of Priestly Formation. The men will spend the year living together in community focusing primarily on growing in friendship with Jesus and each other through prayer and intentional communal life. Seminarian Collin Prom (St. Mary's, Upsala), now in his Discipleship I year, described how living in community helped quell a fear he had about pursuing priesthood — living alone and feeling lonely.

"If priesthood is where you are calling me to be, Lord, I will not be alone because I have these incredible men alongside me," Prom said. "Living in community with guys and getting to share your interior life with other men stirred up a greater desire for the priesthood."

After successful completion of the Propaedeutic stage and upon receiving the recommendation to move forward in seminary study, the Discipleship stage begins. At its core, this stage focuses on growing an intimate relationship with Jesus Christ through reflection and growth in Christian virtue. Prom looks forward to continued time in the seminary with the new structure guiding his studies.

"Getting to learn more about Jesus encouraged me to be able to say, 'Lord, I want to pursue you with my mind. I want to know you more," Prom said. "I can do that by reading and discussing, by coming to classes and by applying myself. It's so cool."
