## The Solemnity of "Christ the King" November 26

With the Feast of Christ the King, we end the liturgical season and begin a new year with the Advent next weekend. This feast day was instituted in 1925 by Pope Pius XI who was concerned about the state of the world in the post-World War I period, a war in which over 9 million soldiers were killed and over 21 million wounded. People seemed to be lost about what had happened and the tension and distress those were in development. In the early 20s Mussolini marched on Rome and formed a Fascist government. Stalin ruled as the Soviet Dictator. We begin to hear of Adolf Hitler. There was fear, a lack of hope, and feelings of helplessness. So the Feast of Christ the King was established as a reminder to all about who is ultimately and eternally in charge.

This fest is very powerful and relevant these days. Jesus represents a kingship that turns our worldly idea of leadership upside down. His kingship is **nonviolent**; it is **Just** and **Peaceful**. His authority is based on the rule of **truth**, **love** and **mercy**. And his kingdom is present until the end of time. It is present now, even in the current midst of chaos and fear happening in the world around us. Let us not focus on the chaos and terror tactics that are trying to separate us from the love of God, but to God and His Kingdom. Jesus will lead us to the everlasting kingdom of life.

Thank you Lord for you are always in control. We trust your eternal nature to be revealed in the body of the sick, to bring peace and healing. Help us in this times to rely only on your power, Amen.
