



I recall the story of a 21st century Chinese Bishop, who was placed in 15 years of solitary confinement. And one day, the officials brought him out and said, 'we are going to give you a break today. For two hours you can do anything or eat anything you want. Do you want to eat your favorite food? Do you want to go for a walk? The Bishop simply replied, 'please give me a bread and some wine.' He celebrated the Mass. And after it was finished, he went back into solitary. The Bishop said that, that single celebration of the Eucharist sustained him, kept him strong and gave him life when he was tempted to give up and die.

Jesus still makes that offer of life to us. He offers us the antidote to the culture of death through the simple, humble gesture of coming under the disguise of bread and wine.
